Online Behaviour Rules

- Students will only engage in online classes during class time and are not permitted to have a phone during that time
- Students will fully engage in the lesson during class time and must not leave the virtual class i.e. students must remain logged on and visible during class
- Students will be familiar with copyright issues relating to online classes. Classes cannot be recorded and notes cannot be copied or shared (ref Terms and Conditions)
- Students will use only Brú na Páirce email accounts they have allocated for course use for any communication in relation to Brú na Páirce
- Users will not send or receive any material that is illegal, obscene, defamatory or that is intended to annoy or intimidate another person
- Users will not reveal their own or other people's personal details, such as addresses or telephone numbers or pictures
- Students will never arrange a face to face meeting with someone •
- Students will note that they can only send email attachments that contain coursework
- All classwork, group work and comhrá will take place under teacher/ceannaire's supervision
- Do not use words or share content that is offensive or inflammatory (this includes but is not limited to, language, names or content that is sexist, racist, homophobic, sexually explicit, abusive, contains swearing or is otherwise likely to cause offence). If you would not say it to someone's face, don't say it online either
- Do not 'spam' other learners by posting the same comment multiple times or by adding comments that are unrelated to the class
- Do not remove another person from the class •
- Only use chat space for communication with teachers/ceannaire's
